

## SENATE COMMITTEE ON STUDENT DISCIPLINE REPORT ON ACADEMIC INTEGRITY VIOLATIONS (FY24)

According to §1-407(d) of the Student Code: "The Director of the Office for Student Conflict Resolution shall compile an annual report to the Senate on the number and severity of such infractions of academic integrity, without identification of the individuals involved. The report shall be available to the public." This report includes all academic integrity infractions reported to the Senate Committee on Student Discipline between July 1, 2023, and June 30, 2024.

In FY24, trained decision-makers under the authority of the Senate Committee on Student Discipline addressed 113 cases in which students had been found responsible for a second, third, etc. academic integrity infraction. As a result, 103 students were placed on conduct probation, 3 students were placed on dismissal held in abeyance status, and 7 were dismissed from the university.

The College of Law does not report violations through the FAIR system and does not input through the FAIR system.

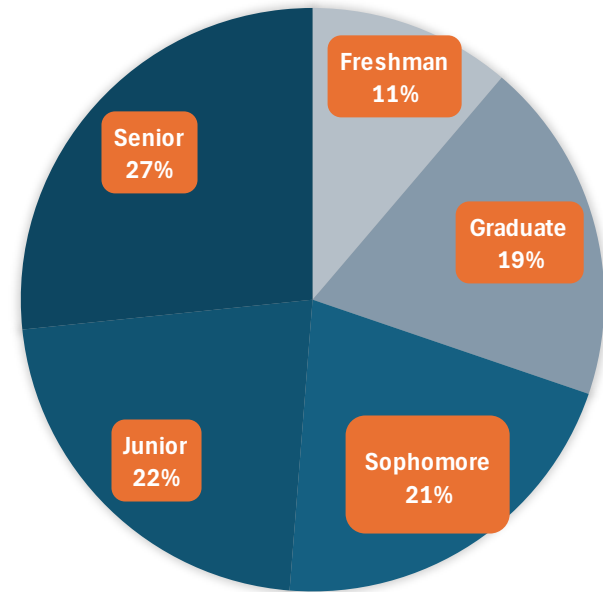

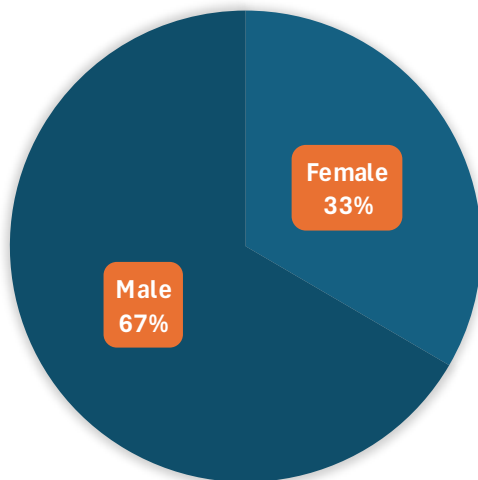
